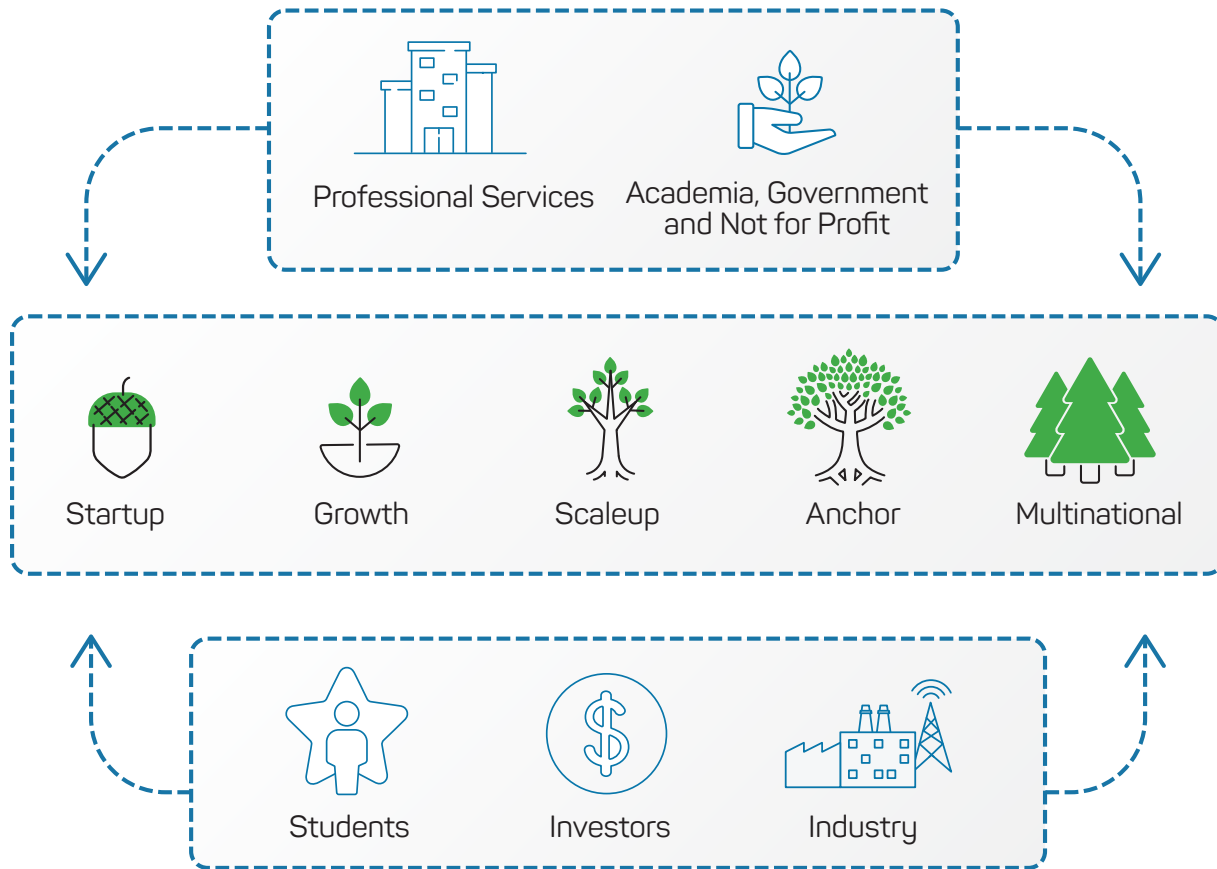

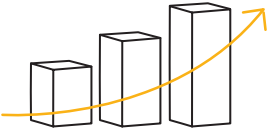
We launched several new membership streams, including dedicated programs for startups, students, industry members, and VCs. We grew member numbers by over 50% and our net promoter score increased to 30. Our weekly newsletter grew to 5,000 subscribers and an open rate of 33%.

We kept our educational programming online and were pleased to see that this enabled greater participation across the province, both at the live recordings and those watching via BC Tech's YouTube channel.

Our members consistently tell us that they most value our advocacy on behalf of the sector and the thought leadership research reports we publish - 5 reports were issued this year. Our most highly-rated member services are our C Councils, our internship program and our expedited visa support.

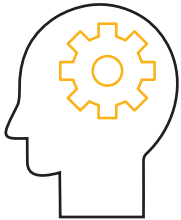
BC Tech membership accelerates the success of our tech company members through:



Educational programming for entrepreneurs on #whatworks for Growth, Scale, Capital, Export, D&I and more – **100+ hours** of programming delivered to **347 members**, **200 connections** of tech companies to new customers, **14 peer-to-peer C Councils** with **252 members** participating.



Research reports and advocacy on the key issues impacting the industry – **5 reports** published on BC's New Economic Narrative, BC's Fiscal Future, BC's Talent Supply Gap, 2SLGBTQ+ in Tech and Advancing BC's Manufacturing Sector; **21 government** roundtables and meetings held.



Growing BC's tech talent pool and increasing pathways for underrepresented groups – **228 individuals** from other sectors reskilled for a job in tech, **240 K-12 educators** supported to bring content on tech trends and tech careers into their classrooms, **23 immigrant entrepreneurs** supported to start their business, **18 members** supported with expedited visa applications, **100 diverse interns** matched with tech companies, **120 job board listings**.
